OVERVIEW

Downtown Indy, Inc.'s 2017 Community Report provides a snapshot of the state of Downtown Indianapolis at year-end 2016, referencing specific economic indicators, strengths and challenges facing the community. Local and national data is sourced throughout the report. Information was gathered by Downtown Indy, Inc. staff and includes data and statistics from local partners as well as peer downtowns across the country.

For the purpose of this report, "Downtown" is defined as the area bounded by 16th Street on the north, I-65/I-70 on the east and south and the White River and Harding Street on the west. Unless otherwise noted, the data in this report reflects this area.



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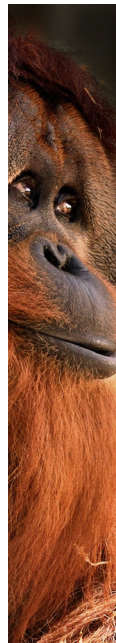

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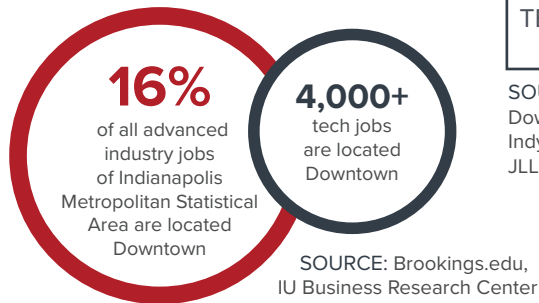

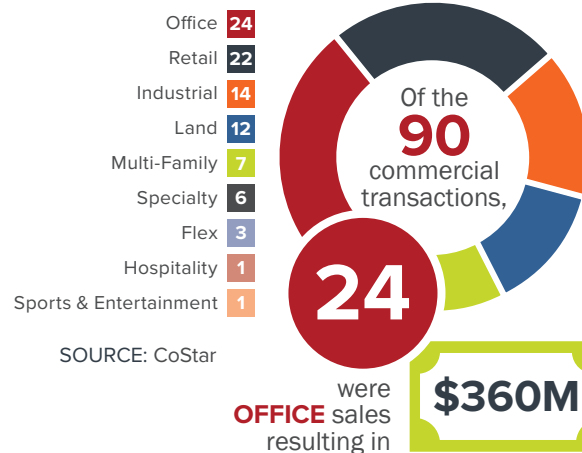

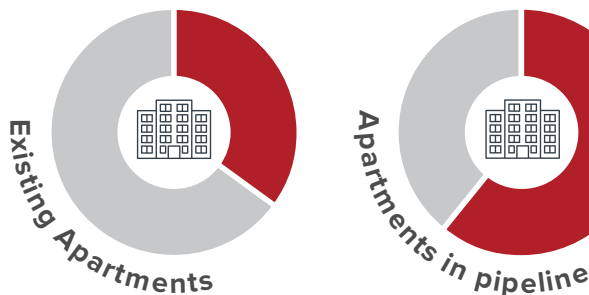

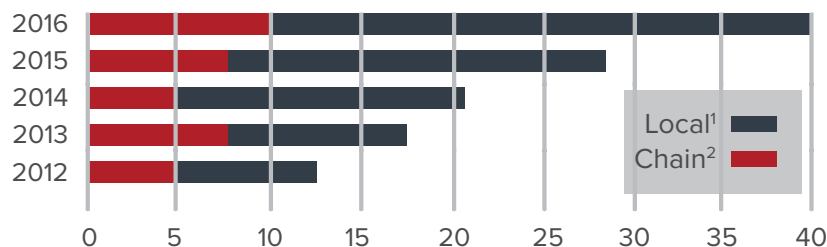

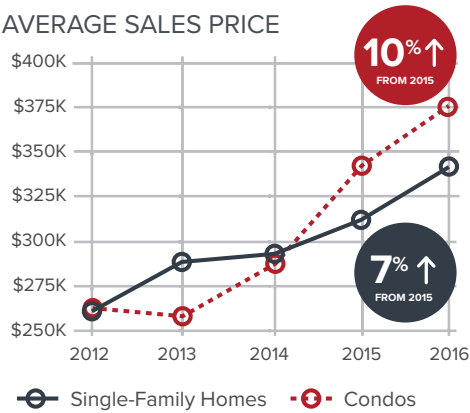

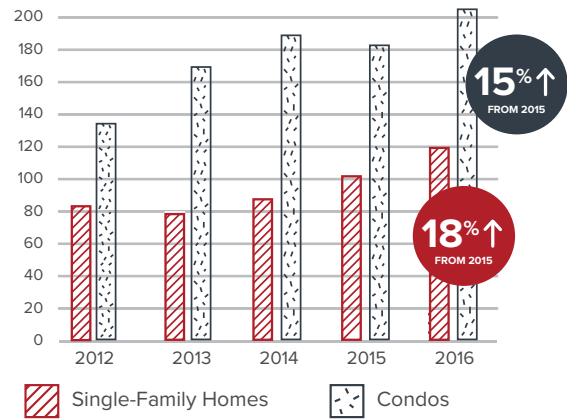
HOME SALES DATA

AVERAGE SALES PRICE

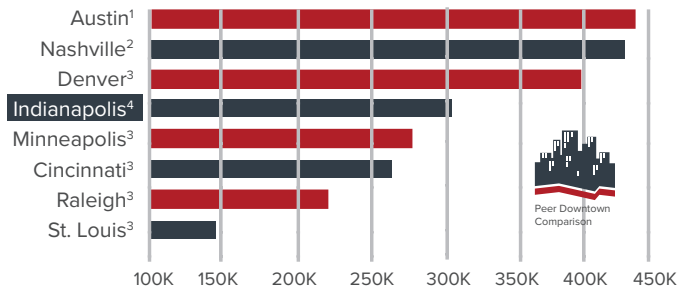

2016 PEER DOWNTOWN MEDIAN HOME VALUES

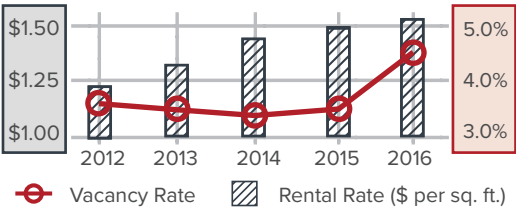

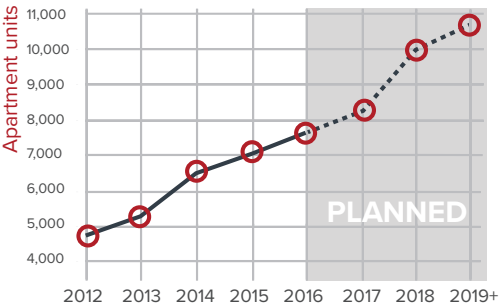
MULTI-FAMILY RENTAL DATA

DOWNTOWN INDY VACANCY RATES AND RENTAL RATES PER SQ. FT.

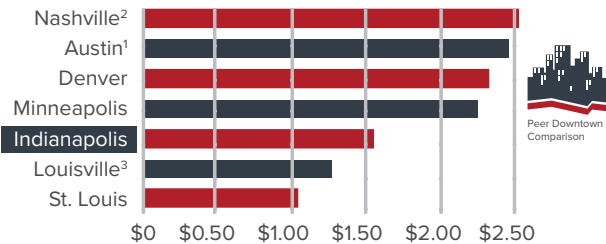

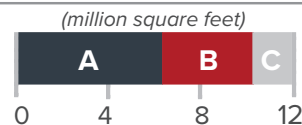

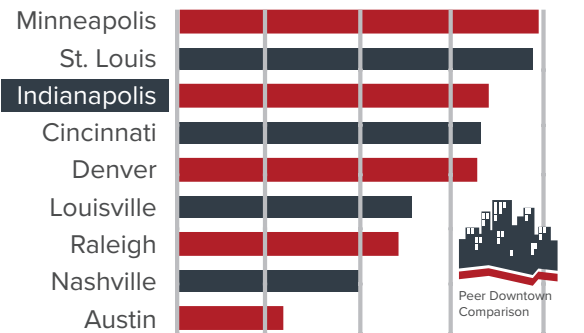

2016 PEER DOWNTOWN OFFICE VACANCY RATE

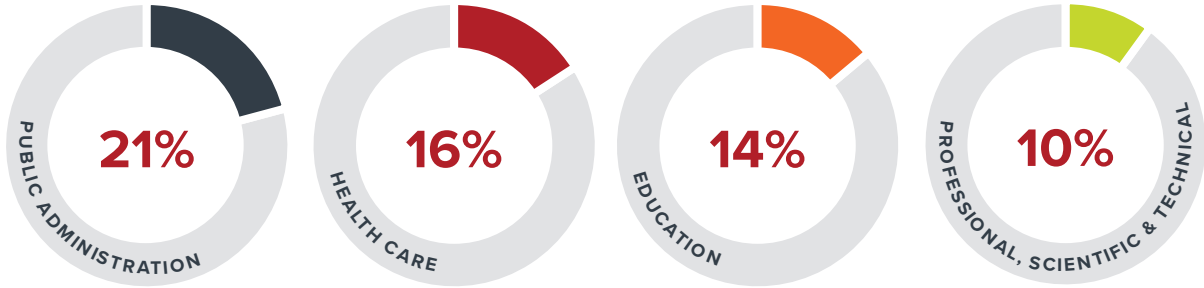

IN 2016, new and existing Indy businesses invested **\$45 MILLION** in growing operations Downtown. This growth resulted in the retention of **2,278** jobs and the creation of **2,243** additional jobs in Downtown Indy.

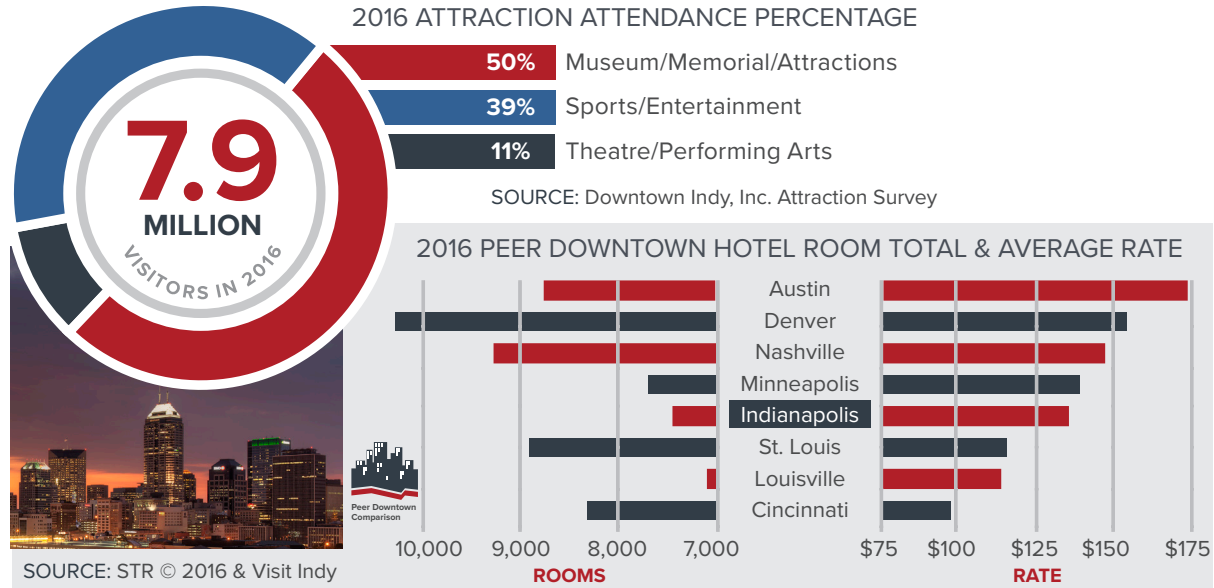

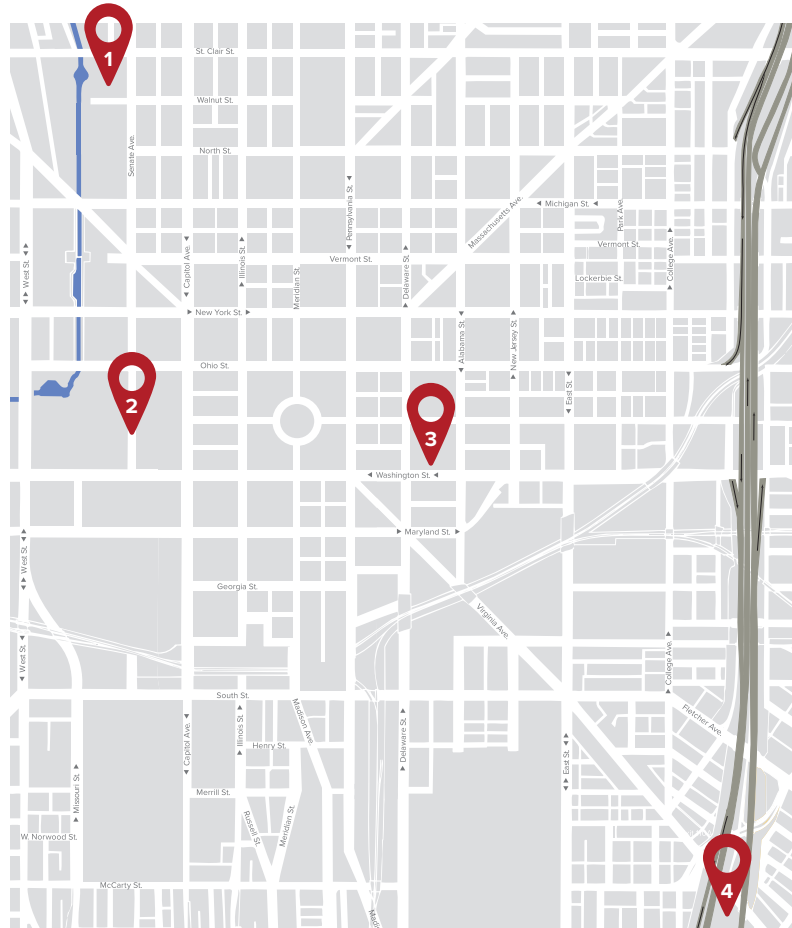
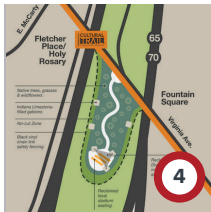

MORE CONDOS

In the past five years, **43** condos and **84** single family homes have been constructed. Currently, **169** condos and **60** single-family homes are under development.* This is an **80 PERCENT** increase in new home ownership opportunities.

MORE TRANSIT

In November 2016, nearly **60 PERCENT** of Marion County voters supported an income tax for transit projects, and on Feb. 27, our City-County Council enacted the tax by a vote of **17-8**. Now IndyGo will begin implementing the significantly better service. This means an efficient grid design, every route every day, less waiting and rapid transit corridors. **AND IT ALL STARTS WITH THE RED LINE.**
